INTER - UNIVERSITY BEST SPEAKER COMPETITION 2021

UNIVERSITY OF KELANIYA



BEST SPEAKER 2021 is an inter - university **English public speaking contest** organized by the University of Kelaniya Gavel Club.

The contest is open for all state universities island wide.

There will be three (3) rounds of the contest:

- 1. Preliminary Round
- 2. Semi- final Round
- 3. Final Round

The Preliminary Round will comprise of a prepared speech category where the contestant has to submit a video of the prepared speech.

The Semi-final Round and the Final Round will comprise of two categories, namely; the Prepared Speech Category and the Impromptu Speech Category.

Please note that participation in both categories is mandatory for contestants selected for the Semi-final and the Final Rounds.

The Preliminary Round will be conducted through video submissions and the Semi-Final Round and the Final Round will be carried through online speech delivery.

General rules applicable:



01. Registration

(A) Eligibility

To be eligible to compete in the contest, a contestant must:

- Be an undergraduate of a state university recognized by the UGC (University Grants Commission) of Sri Lanka or any other government university established by Acts of Parliament of Sri Lanka.
- Not be a winner of a previous Best Speaker Contest organized by the University of Kelaniya Gavel Club.
- (B) Identification
 - Contestants must attach a clear image of one of the following documents with the online application form to prove his/her identity as an undergraduate of the represented university.
 - o University Identity Card
 - University Record Book

or else the contestants have to provide their University E-mail Address as a proof of their identity.



02.Competition

(A) Language

- All speeches should be delivered in **English**.
- Any quote or phrase expressed in a different language should be translated back to English.
- Use of profane language may result a disqualification or a deduction of points.

(B) Speech Rounds:

- The contest will comprise of three (3) rounds, namely;
 - 1. Preliminary Round
 - 2. Semi-final Round
 - 3. Final Round
- Rules and Regulations for each round are as follows:

1. Preliminary Round

- a) A **recorded video** of the prepared speech should be submitted in this round.
- b) Speech Timing:
 - Speech should be **between 4 to 6 minutes**.
 - Contestant will be disqualified if the speech falls short of 3 minute 30 seconds or if it exceeds 6 minutes 30 seconds.
 - The timing will begin from the first obvious verbal or non-verbal gesture of the contestant.
- c) Speech content
 - Contestants are free to speak on any topic of their choice. However, speech content which discriminates a particular section of a community or is politically motivated may result in a disqualification or reduction of points.
 - Contestants must prepare their own speeches, and the speech must be substantially original. Any quote, paraphrased or referenced content must be so identified during the speech presentation.
- d) Speech submission:
 - The video should be submitted before the deadline.
 - Video submission guidelines will be emailed to the contestant after the registration.



- The video should be recorded in the landscape format (recording device held horizontally).
- The video should not be a selfie video and should not contain any video effects appearing on the screen.
- The video should have a clear audio with a minimum level of background sounds and noises.
- The video should properly present the speaker in a clear background as shown below.



e) Dress code:

• All participants must be dressed in formal attire.

2. Semi-final Round

a) The Semi-final Round will comprise of two categories, namely; the **Prepared Speech** category and the **Impromptu Speech** category.

- Participation in both categories is mandatory for all semifinalists.
- The Prepared and Impromptu speech categories will be held on two different days.

b) The Semi-final Round will be held online through the Zoom video conferencing application.

c) Speech Timing:

Prepared Speech

- Speech should be **between 5 to 7 minutes.**
- Speaker will be disqualified if the speech falls short of 4 minutes 30 seconds or if it exceeds 7 minutes 30 seconds.



Impromptu Speech

- Speech should be **between 1 minute to 2 minutes**.
- Contestant will be disqualified if the speech falls short of 1 minute or if it exceeds 2 minutes 30 seconds.

e) Dress code:

• All participants must be dressed in a formal attire.

3. Final Round

a) The Final round will comprise of two categories, namely; the Prepared Speech category and the Impromptu Speech category.

- Participation in both categories is mandatory for all finalists.
- The Prepared and Impromptu Speech categories will be held on the day of Grand Finals.
- b) The Final round will be held online through the Zoom video conferencing application.

c) Speech Timing:

Prepared Speech

- Speech should be **between 5 to 7 minutes**.
- Speaker will be disqualified if the speech falls short of 4 minutes 30 seconds or if it exceeds 7 minutes 30 seconds.

Impromptu Speech

- Speech should be between **1 minute to 2 minutes**.
- Contestant will be disqualified if the speech falls short of 1 minute or if it exceeds 2 minutes 30 seconds.
- d) Dress code:
 - All participants must be dressed in a formal attire.



03. Guidelines

(A) Use of visual aids

- The use visual aids such as slide projectors and charts will not be permitted.
- (B) Disqualifications and Final decision
 - Before a contestant can be disqualified on the basis of originality, the contestant will be given an opportunity to respond to the judges. A majority of the judges must concur in the decision to disqualify.
 - The decision of the judges will be final. If a situation arises where 2 or more contestants have an equal number of points, the Tie-breaking judge will be involved in making the final decision.
- (C) Order of speaking
 - Lots will be drawn digitally to determine the order of speaking at the Semifinal and Final Rounds.
- (D) Selection of winners
 - 20 contestants and 2 reserves (subject to change depending on the number of contestants at the Preliminary Round) will be selected to the Semi-final Round.
 - 6 contestants will be selected from the Semi-final Round to compete at the Final Round. In addition, 2 reserves will also be selected.
 - Best Speaker, First Runner-up, Second Runner-up, Best Prepared Speaker and Best Impromptu Speaker will be selected in the Final Round.
 - The decision of the judges will be final.



04.Speech Evaluation Criteria

Speeches will be judged on the basis of the following criteria.

Prepared Speech

Speech Content (50%)

- Speech Development Structure, organization and support material
- Effectiveness Achievement of purpose, interest and reception
- Speech value Ideas, logic and originality of thoughts

Speech Delivery (30%)

- Physical Appearance, body language and speaking area
- Manner Directness, assurance and enthusiasm
- Voice Flexibility and volume

Language (20%)

- Appropriateness To speech purpose and to audience
- Correctness Grammar, pronunciation and word selection

Impromptu Speech

Speech Content (55%)

- Speech Development Opening, body, close, organization, smoothness
- Effectiveness Logic, directness, enthusiasm, achievement of purpose, audience response

Speech Delivery (30%)

- Physical Appearance, body language and speaking area
- Voice Flexibility and volume

<u>Language (15%)</u>

- Appropriateness To speech purpose and to audience
- Correctness Grammar, pronunciation and word selection
