Notice

Submitting MCs for being absent from an examinations

- Any student sitting for an examination falling ill must obtain an MC from nearest Government Hospital or the UMO.
- Any MCs obtained other than from a Government Hospital will be considered suspicious MCs.
- Under no circumstances should an MC obtained from a Private Dispensary or Nursing home be accepted or authorized by the UMO unless approved by the committee appointed by the Senate.

Students falling ill during examinations

- Any student falling ill during an examination should consult the UMO before leaving the University premises
- Whenever the UMO is available at the health center, the students must approach the UMO for medical attention.
- If UMO is unavailable at the health center, students falling ill must get medical attention from the nearest Government Hospital.
- Mass absenteeism for any examination with medical certificates is considered a suspicious case. Therefore, the committee appointed by the Senate will deal with it.

Students may not be able to attend an examination for other than medical reasons, such as the death of a parent, guardian or sibling. Such cases also have to be dealt with, case by case, by the committee appointed by the Senate.
